Job Title: Distribution Maintainer

Objectives: To maintain up-to-date versions of the software packages used in CRE&T distributions.

Duties and Responsibilities: Distribution Maintainer will be responsible to download and maintain the latest versions of those packages CRE&T uses to build its computers. Distribution Maintainer will compile CDs and test them in different hardware and software environments. Distribution Maintainer will be responsible to create and maintain a change log.

Qualifications and Requirements: Applicant should know how to download programs. Applicant must have a good eye for details. It is preferable that applicant has a broadband internet connection at their own residence, but this is not a requirement.

Lines of Communication: You will work under the direction of our Build Manager and our Systems Manager.

Orientation and Training: A one hour orientation will be provided outside of normal business hours.

Times Needed and Place of Work: One to three hours per week during business hours. This work may be done either on the CRE&T premises or else uploaded via a VPN connection to a server either for or at CRE&T.

Commitment Required: Distributions should ordinarily be updated every week. Delivery of new distribution should be submitted for review each Monday. Depending on the updates involved, this may take between six to twelve hours monthly.

Benefits: The Distribution Maintainer will learn trends in our distribution and learn a few tricks of the trade. References provided.

Frustrations: Compiling a distribution and testing it is unforgiving. One mistake and you must start over.

Satisfactions: Maintenance of proper and up-to-date distributions is a key to the workflow in our organization. Applicant may rest assured that the applicant is performing a vital function that has definite results.
