

## **CRE& Triage Worker Level 2 Volunteer Position Description v0.01**

**Organization:** Computer Recycling Education & Training

**Job Title:** Triage Worker - Level 2 - Component Tester.

**Objectives:** To test monitors, printers, scanners, power supplies, and UPS units.

**Duties and Responsibilities:** Component Testers are responsible for some amount of quality control. The test components and then place those components which pass the test into appropriate locations. They tag and place failed components into appropriate recycling areas.

**Qualifications and Requirements:** Applicant should have successfully completed CRE&T Disassembly and Triage Level 1 training. Applicant should be familiar with testing procedures. Applicant should have read the appropriate CRE&T Triage documents.

**Lines of Communication:** You will work under the direction of our Triage Manager.

**Orientation and Training:** Some training periods will be provided outside of normal CRE&T business hours. This training will be under the guidance of the Triage manager.

**Times Needed and Place of Work:** 3 hours per week during daytime business hours, Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday. Additional two or four hours of orientation before the work commences.

**Commitment Required:** A minimum of 3 hours per week is required for a minimum of 4 weeks.

**Benefits:** Excellent experience; references provided. This teaches some of the finer points about monitors, printers, and other components. Triage testers learn when and why certain components might be used.

**Frustrations:** As with most jobs, there can be a fair amount of tedium involved.

**Satisfactions:** An excellent introduction. One should develop a sense of the finer qualities of computers and their components.
