Organization: Computer Recycling Education & Training

Job Title: Triage Worker - Level 4 - Computer Pre-Builder.

Objectives: To ready an incomplete computer for software triage

Duties and Responsibilities: To add floppy drives, cd-rom drives, and or/minimal amounts of memory to flesh out a computer enough so that it might complete the software triage procedure.

Qualifications and Requirements: Applicant should have a thorough understanding of all previous levels of disassembly and triage. Applicant should have read all appropriate disassembly and triage documents, as well as reviewed any other teaching media for these areas, such as slideshows.

Lines of Communication: You will work under the direction of our Triage Manager.

Orientation and Training: Some training periods will be provided outside of normal CRE&T business hours. This training will be under the guidance of the Triage manager.

Times Needed and Place of Work: 3 hours per week during daytime business hours, Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday. Additional two or four hours of orientation before the work commences.

Commitment Required: A minimum of 3 hours per week is required for a minimum of 4 weeks.

Benefits: Excellent experience; references provided. This teaches some of the preliminary steps involved with actually building a computer from scratch.

Frustrations: As with most jobs, there can be a fair amount of tedium involved.

Satisfactions: At this point, a person acquires the rudimentary skills and knowledge necessary to start building a computer. They begin to see some of the relationship between hardware and software in a computer.
