The Thurston – Santo Tomás Sister Community Association (TSTSCA) works with our partners in Santo Tomás, Chontales, Nicaragua on cultural and educational exchanges as well as critical material aid projects. Your financial and personal contributions will determine how much we can accomplish in 2017.



We are proud of these accomplishments in 2016:

- Our eleventh delegation from Santo Tomás came to Olympia and each of the four guests had an awesome time. Yuri, Thelma, Cesar and Aminta enjoyed wonderful home stays and we are grateful to everyone who helped make it a successful exchange. Our guests focused on observing and participating in various educational experiences in the community. They spent time in classes and with student organizations at The Evergreen State College. They visited our sister school Lincoln Options Elementary, as well as Olympia High School and Evergreen Elementary in the Shelton School District. Two of our guests with public health interests were able to connect with physicians and nurses in clinics and hospital settings.
- ► The Scholarship Program continues to help fourteen Tomasinos/as attend college in Nicaragua (including one student in Cuba) leading to completion of their undergrad-uate degrees. Our commitment this year is to raise \$6,720. for these students. Nine more have already graduated. One of the recent graduates as well as the coordinator of the scholarship program were delegates from Santo Tomás to Olympia last spring. It was inspiring to feel their enthusiasm for this life changing project. Please take a few moments to read featured scholar Cristhian Lazo's story in the Update.
- ► The *Comedor/Biblioteca* project support helps provide free lunches to over one hundred hungry children each day and books and space where young students can read and study. This \$10,000 -per-year project requires our ongoing support for the modest salaries of three staff members of the kitchen and library.

We support the Santo Tomás community in other ways. The Nicaraguan local committee guides our efforts from the grassroots up, and we respond, as we are able, to the needs they identify and prioritize. Our relationship is one of exchange and learning from each other.
