Martha Irene Lazo and Heylin Amarely Lopez are teachers in the Rubén Darío School, Santo Tomás's sister school with Olympia's Lincoln Elementary School. They will participate in a variety of activities here.

This delegation will focus on education and several activities with Lincoln School, and also will participate in a variety of activities in Olympia and our region. **Please join them at the various public events!** The *Update* provides exciting information about their visit and TSTSCA's other activities.

While delegations are TSTSCA's most visible activity, our work in Santo Tomás continues all year around and needs ongoing financial support. Our current activities include:

- Our scholarships help nine Tomasinos attend college leading to completing their degrees.
- Our support for the Comedor and Library provides free lunches to about 150 poor children each day and books and space where kids can read and study. This \$7,200-per-year project needs our ongoing support for small salaries for three staff members in the kitchen and library.
- We help the Santo Tomás community in other ways. Their local committee guides our efforts from the grassroots up, and we respond to the needs they identify and prioritize. Our relationship is one of exchange and learning from each other, rather than paternalism.

We respectfully request your support for TSTSCA's efforts to strengthen and support our sister community in the second poorest country in the hemisphere (behind Haiti).
