Evie shared that budget is on schedule and no problems seen on the horizon for the end of the year fulfillment of pledges or unexpected expenditures.

The Fruit Sale was discussed. Kathleen announced that Nika Keller will manage the revenue and sale orders. The agenda for the next Town Hall on October 14, 2012 is Fruit Sale beneficiary selection by CIC . There is a need for committed sellers and deliverers. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm
