

**CIC Special Town Hall for Fruit Sale Decisions
Oct. 13, 2013**

At it's special meeting to decide which applicants would receive money from the 2013 CIC Fruit Sale, Town Hall set some kind of record.

The community agreed unanimously to fund all requests presented at the amounts requested, providing the sale generated enough money. (And since these minutes are three months late, this correspondent can say there was enough money raised.)

Requests were made for the Pizza Klatch LBGT support program in local high schools (\$1,000); the Amahoro House homeless hospice project (\$500); food supplies for CIC's meals at the Salvation Army (\$1,200), Camp Quixote (\$600), the Olympia Pie Guild Sale fundraiser for the Foodbank (\$250), the Tibetan Childrens' Education Foundation (\$1,080), and for SunFunder's loans to support replacing kerosene lamps in Africa with solar lights (\$1,000).
