

## Town Hall Minutes Oct 14, 2018

In attendance were Kathy Pruitt as Town Hall facilitator, Patti Logan, Judy Olmstead, Karen Kirsch, Dick and Betty Hauser, Corey Passons, Tim McCloud from Planned Parenthood, Karen Ray and Penny Purkerson.

The entire meeting was dedicated to hearing proposals for the 2018 fruit sale proceeds.

1. Tim McCloud came from Planned Parenthood and the youth peer education program called teen council. They (15 HS students,) work with 7 different schools this year on gender identify, bullying and harassment issues. They would use the money for training and conferences, guest speakers and for food when the council meets. They are asking for \$500.00.
2. Judy presented for Empowerment 4 Girls. It is a non-profit for girls aged 9 to 16 offering one day camps in the school year and 3, week long camps in the summer of 2019. 66 girls are served. \$375 would give one scholarship to a girl for summer camp. And/or, they are asking for \$500.00 to be used for core support for their operations/outreach. Total could be \$875.00 for both requests.
3. Karen Kirsch requested money for Wild Grief and a program open to teens who have experienced a death. \$240 is the request to feed 4 teens for 4 days on a back packing trip, (\$60/hiker) and \$124 for Intercity van rental and the cost of gas for one trip. Total request is \$364.
4. Kathy Pruitt presented for Kathy Kinard for the Salvation Army Community kitchen. \$2,400 is requested for groceries for the 12 meals CIC provides.
5. We proposed up to \$300.00 be given to Heifer International. CIC children will be invited to select where our donations go through Heifer.

If we make more money than's requested, we'll divide it up between Wild Grief, Empowerment 4 Girls and Heifer Int. in equal amounts. If we have less money than requested, we'll reduce all (except the Community Kitchen), by the percentage we are short from the \$2039 total for the 4 other requests. With the Community Kitchen amt. of \$2400 included, we're hoping to fund \$4439.00 with our sale proceeds. (\$4439-\$2400=\$2039)
