Hugh welcomed us,

Corey led the **Racial Justice Centering** on Harm Reduction and Policing.

Question for a volunteer to lead Racial Justice Centering at a future TH meeting, Christine Forbes volunteered.

Agenda:

Karen read minutes from June 1 Town Hall, no correction.

Dick announced about wanting to eliminate the Comcast account and transition to Gmail. Thanks to Dick to managing that account.

Corey: Minister's Report:

Sabbatical Jan and Feb. Corey away. Last Christmas eve till Easter. March is integration month. Corey started a Celebration Planning Cohort. Proposed structure of IF Guest Speakers program. We'd like to have a Sunday for discussion of IF dialogue and help with this sharing. Proposed an 8 week series with CIC folks- interspersed with 4 guests from the community. Corey asked: How does having 4 guests feel, over 2 months? Guests might relieve CIC some responsibility while Corey on sabbatical.

Feedback?

- **Jamie:** Every other week theme has the usual amount of CIC leading. We hope it will be expansive to heart and mind.
- **Betty**: great idea. We are an interfaith community, great fun to have input from others with comparing/sharing form the wider interfaith community. Contrast with other religious leaders.
- **Tara**: asking guests to hold our theme for the year.
- Corey said guest list so far is: Rev. Mary from OUUC, Rabbi Seth, an Islamic center guest (Imam?) and Amy Cooper from IF works from the Wiccan tradition.
- **Betty:** ask them to include practices rather than just talking; practices for CIC to experience their religion.
- Penny: we have the dates all filled in these 8 weeks. Final celebration would be harvesting from

the series, lead by Celebration Planning. CIC to share from: Buddhist, Sufi, Christianity, etc.

Corey got affirmation from those gathered at town hall. Thanks to Celebration. Planning and Steer Circle.

Corey working with **Karen** Ray on a booklet to share roles, info, practical things while Corey is gone. Steering Circle to help folks in their extra roles, etc.

Children's program: Elise now in the classroom. **Corey** to meet with **Cindy** GA and families of CIC to find out how they envision kids program, how CIC can support them. Goal of growing kids program and support new and existing families.

Thad: via zoom **Finance Report**: gathered folks have a paper copy of Sept 2025 Budget Report ... Usual- spending as expected/ **Corey** spent 1/3 of prof expenses. \$ to Miriam as expected, Aubrey paid about half as expected, Elise to be paid some of what was left from Aubry's position. Paying out as expected: workers comp, L and I, family leave and medical insurance. Spent a bit more (82 % instead of 72%) and a bit more for space rental to...TUCO, FUMCO? (maybe \$ returned from TUCO.) We are in good shape in general. Not much to say. Spent 77% of duplication budget, unusual. Totals:Expenditures: \$40,798. Pledge income is \$36,088. (\$1.251 from begging bowl,) pledges go up and down.

- Budget \$4500. deficit expected to be covered with accumulated surplus.
- We made a \$10,000. donation for TUCO remodel.
- Now have \$7,084. in checking and various CD's with interest coming in. Any questions? **Penny** asked if the donation to TUCO has come out and shown in this budget? Yes. Interfaith works money spent?, Yes a once a year expense.
- Corey asked: Hugh, Penny, what help do you need for pledge gathering support? Yes we have a deficit. We planned on a budget deficit of \$4,600. Penny to get in touch with folks whose pledge hasn't come in yet. Penny wants someone else to do the thermometer. Carol volunteered to make a thermometer. Penny will give Carol the #'s.
- Penny: we need the budget first, have a target, then start fundraising for 2026. Thad and Penny to draft a preliminary draft budget for next year. Thanks you Thad! Great spreadsheets!

(No Call Shepherd report- Call Shepherd not here.) Committee reports:

Betty: Social Justice: discussed changes in website and Wavelinks, **Betty** says she is not "the most interested" in changing Wavelinks, but goal is to change newsletter to make it more user friendly, as it is too long, too much content. **Safia** Crane looks at Unity newsletter. (Sample) very professional, it has

a photos, short entries, and categories, last one is a community corner. **Scott** not interested in doing links every week nor photos and graphics, hopefully a meeting of committee minds. Will gather to move forward. **Betty** asks: What would be nice, what makes sense, we need a few more people. **Tara:** Melanie does this (tech) for a living, started a Whats'App for CIC (might she help with website, etc.?) **Thad** would be on committee. Have a sub-committee on communication? Thanks given to Betty.

Community Kitchen: Alan, Bethanie, and Richard are committee, need more for 2 shifts. 50 meals "to go" and 200 cooked, 60 to Unity commons, food prices going up. Long time paid staff at CK retired, looking for new person. Hugh: sustainable costs for the future? Leeann: fundraising?

Community support, Sabra-and Bethanie organize support for community, illnesses and new babies, etc. They are looking for new team member for "meal-train organizer." Interested? Get a hold of Bethanie and Sabra. They also want new member, **Bethanie** to pass the torch to someone new. Opportunity!!

Connections Committee: Evaluation summary, not this time, next Town Hall on Oct 26.

Retreats: Leeann with help Carol and Hilarie in past. Christine F. and Nikka are now this committee. Retreat in May is booked at Millersylvania. Leeann asked Corey if he tried for fall? He has tried for 2 years. Discussion to try again in Fall with a 3 day instead of 2 day. Unknown. Have to apply 365 days in advance. Email application at 7:00 am one year in advance. Corey tried and it didn't work. Any inquiries about Gwinwood? Yes in the past. Have we looked at Pilgrim Firs, the UCC church camp? Tara has cooked there for private retreats. A possibility. Gig Harbor. Swimming, boating, etc.

Fundraising: Leeann, check in with Gene, didn't know at first, price of fish really high, then a "Yes" to selling fish, we might charge double..(Gene wants us to sell it for what the food co-op sells it for.) Gene goes out on a limb to get fish and there are unpredictable aspects of the Fish Sale.

Leeann contacted Jan re: Theater fundraiser, way more \$. Peg: Harlequin offers opportunities for non-profits on dress-rehersal on eve of opening night.. We don't know what shows are yet for 2026. Peg looked at all of the shows, some would not work for out for CIC. Peg selected one, Harlequin will not commit until October. We may not get our first choice. Peg to make a second choice on last day of Sept. - to help plan ahead. It was a fun social event, we learned a lot. Peg wants choice to be good for kids, no violence, not dark. What do we look for re: community building? Long term, it's dependent on what shows are offered.

Leeann: yes to fish sale 2025, don't know for 2026. **Leeann's** last yr. in this role. Should CIC designate a percentage back to Harlequin? **Peg** want small committee, not just she and Jan Rocks. First choice of play is Feb/March,: "The Foreigner," or October. #2 choice is Oscar Wilde's, "The Importance of being Earnest."

TUCO renovation, Betty - a little behind. Maybe mid November or October. It's fluid. Stay tuned. Oct. 1st meeting.

New TH Dates 10/26 and Dec.14. draft budget for 2026.

Draft budget on 10/26, begin pledge drive.
